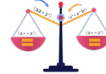

English

Introduction to safety & emergency measures, infection control, resident rights & communication as it relates to long term care

BIO 120

Anatomy & Physiology I

This course introduces the student to anatomy and physiology, the structure and function of the human body. Students will learn the structure and function of the following systems: integumentary, skeletal, muscular, cardiovascular, blood, lymphatic and immune systems cardiovascular, blood, lymphatic and immune systems.

BIO 120-L

Anatomy & Physiology I Lab

This virtual lab course complements the lecture content by providing interactive, hands-on experience with the structure and function of the human body. Students will engage with virtual models, simulations, and interactive exercises covering the integumentary, skeletal, muscular, cardiovascular, blood, lymphatic, and immune systems.

CLSC 2429

Clinical Microbiology in Healthcare

This course introduces fundamental microbiology concepts, focusing on microorganisms and their interactions with humans and the environment. Topics include microbial classification, cell types and survival processes, bacterial metabolism, nutrition, genetics, antimicrobial strategies, and pathogenic mechanisms. A virtual lab complements lecture content, providing hands-on experience. This foundational course is ideal for students pursuing health profession programs.

GEN 108

Algebra I

This course examines real numbers, variables, linear equations and inequalities, exponents, polynomials, order of operations, and word problems. Focus of these topics is the development of problem-solving skills and critical thinking.
